World Heritage in Germany

- Year of ratification : 1976
- 40 properties
 - → first inscription in **1978**: Aachen Cathedral
 - → last inscription in 2015: Hamburg Speicherstadt and Kontorhaus District with Chilehaus
- Types of properties:
 - 37 cultural, and 3 natural properties
 - Types of cultural properties: historic urban areas, monuments and ensembles, and cultural landscapes






